The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jerry Garrett. Minutes of the July 19 meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance No. 90-429, an ordinance to amend the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Section 13-203(e), to require residential and commercial property owners to be responsible for repair of their sewer service lines within the City of Goodlettsville. Third reading. The City Attorney explained that the ordinance had been amended since second reading to delete the section which placed a lien on property to pay for repairs made by the City. Motion by Long to approve the amendment. Seconded by Filson and passed unanimously. Motion by Long to pass the amended ordinance on third reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 90-433, an ordinance to amend Title 1, Chapter 11 (Board of Parks & Recreation) of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, being Ordinance No. 67-79, as amended. Third reading. Motion by Filson to pass on third reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 90-434, an ordinance to amend Title 11, Chapter 7, Sections 11-703 and 11-704, and Chapter 11, Sections 11-1105(f)(1) and (3) of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code (Ordinance No. 89-413, as amended) by deleting and adding various provisions. First reading. The City Planner explained the proposed changes to the zoning ordinance. Motion by Garrett to pass the ordinance on first reading. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 90-435, an ordinance to establish procedure to read only the caption of an ordinance in accordance with the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Chapter 20, Section 6-20-215 (Ordinance Procedure) of the Charter for the City of Goodlettsville. First reading. Motion by Filson to pass on first reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

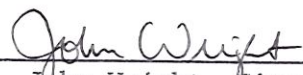
Consider approval of Change Order No. 10 on the new City Hall. The City Manager explained that this change order includes all the final changes and two deductions, one for an item in Change Order No. 8 that was not completed and one for utility bills paid by the City which should have been paid by the contractor. Motion by Filson to approve Change Order No. 10 in the amount of \$5404.55. Seconded by Garrett. Passed unanimously.

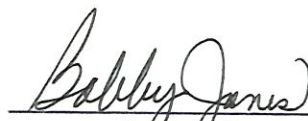

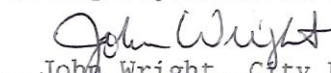
The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Joe Haynes. Minutes of the August 16 meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance No. 90-435, an ordinance to establish procedure to read only the caption of an ordinance in accordance with the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Chapter 20, Section 6-20-215 (Ordinance Procedure) of the Charter of the City of Goodlettsville. Second reading. Motion by Long to pass on second reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 90-436, an ordinance to amend the Sewer Use Ordinance, No. 82-283, Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 13, Chapter 2. First reading. Randy Tatum summarized the new EPA guidelines that require modification of the sewer use ordinance with regard to discharge of hazardous materials and penalties for violations. Motion by Filson to pass on first reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed unanimously.

The City Manager announced that the City employee picnic will be held on Saturday, September 29, at Moss-Wright Park.
