The City Manager requested that the revised Park Board Ordinance be passed on caption on first reading. There was no objection to considering the matter. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 90-433, an ordinance to amend Title I, Chapter 11, of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, on caption on first reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Motion by Garrett to allocate \$2000 out of the budget for the Goodlettsville Firefighters Auxiliary annual Christmas party for needy children. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Prayer was offered by Joe Haynes. Minutes of the July 5 meeting were approved as submitted.

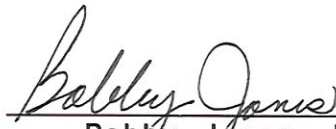

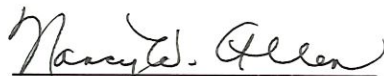
Ordinance No. 90-432, an ordinance to amend Title I, Chapter 10, Section 1-1001 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code concerning business dealings of City personnel with the City..third reading. On a motion by Garrett, second by Filson, third reading on Ordinance No. 90-432 was deferred until the next meeting.

Ordinance No. 90-433, an ordinance to amend Title I, Chapter 11 (Board of Parks & Recreation) of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, being Ordinance No. 67-79, as amended..second reading. Three minor revisions to the ordinance were requested by the City Manager. He also asked the City Attorney for clarification on the Park Board having the authority to establish fees and charges (1-1102 {5}). Should not the Commission have final approval? Haynes had no problem with the Park Board setting fees, but agreed that the Commission should have the final vote. On a motion by Filson, second by Long, Ordinance No. 90-433 passed on second reading subject to the changes recommended by the City Manager and the addition of wording of the City Attorney that fee schedules be brought before the Commission for final approval.

Consider approval of form to be used for collection of Hotel/Motel 3% Occupancy Tax, in accordance with Ordinance No. 90-430, Section 5. On a motion by Garrett, second by Filson, this form was approved.
