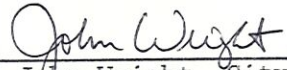


Consider an ordinance to require property owners to be responsible for repair of their sewer service lines. The City Manager explained that as part of the effort to stop inflow and infiltration of ground water into the sewer lines, a means of requiring the repair of leaks discovered on private property is needed. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 90-429 on caption on first reading. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

Consider the request of Billy Hitt, owner of certain property on Old Springfield Highway, that the Commission take action on his offer to convey said property to the City of Goodlettsville subject to certain stipulations. Motion by Garrett to accept the offer to sell the property for \$48,000 under the stipulated conditions. Seconded by Long. Motion by Garrett to amend his original motion to accept the offer provided that the adjacent property owned by Billy Benz is also acquired at an equivalent cost per acre. Motion to amend seconded by Filson. Both the amendment and original motion passed unanimously.

The City Manager requested that the Commission adopt a resolution honoring the Goodlettsville High School Class of 1935 which is holding its 55th reunion. Motion by Filson to adopt Resolution No. R90-106. Seconded by Garrett. Passed unanimously.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Johnny Long. Minutes of the May 17 meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance No. 90-426, an ordinance of the City of Goodlettsville adopting a budget and establishing a property tax rate for the fiscal year July 1, 1990, through June 30, 1991. Second reading. Motion by Long to pass on second reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 90-427, an ordinance requiring the posting of address numbers, plainly visible on mail box or front of building, in connection with the 911 emergency program. Second reading. Motion by Childers to pass on second reading. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 90-428, an ordinance to amend Title 10, Chapter 2, Section 10-214, by deleting subparagraph (d) and Section 10-215 in its entirety, being a portion of the Criminal Code ordinance amendment (No. 89-419) as it refers to the discharge of firearms. Second reading. Motion by Long to pass on second reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

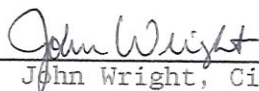

Consider an ordinance to impose a hotel/motel tax for the City of Goodlettsville. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 90-430, imposing a hotel/motel tax for the City of Goodlettsville, on caption on first reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Consider an ordinance to set the date of the next City election on October 4, 1990. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 90-431, setting the next City election on October 4, 1990, on caption on first reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.
