

MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: April 27, 1990

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones for the purpose of considering action regarding the Order and Assessment from the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Health and Environment, Case No. 89-3346, dated April 12, 1990, involving the City of Goodlettsville sanitary sewer collector system.

City Engineer Pete Ragan outlined the main points of the letter from Metro regarding the capacities of the Goodlettsville Pump Station and the Dry Creek Treatment Plant and the flow rates generated by the Goodlettsville Sewer System.

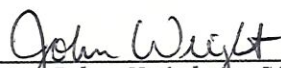
City Attorney Joe Haynes informed the Commission that he had met with the attorney for the State Water Quality Control Board about appealing the sewer moratorium order.

After a discussion of the possible courses of action to take, Garrett moved that the City Attorney be directed to file an appeal of the order from the Tennessee Department of Health and Environment, Case No. 89-3346. Filson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Filson moved that the City Engineer be directed to proceed with all deliberate speed to locate a suitable site and develop the engineering for a sewer equalization pond. Garrett seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Garrett moved that the Director of Public Works be directed to proceed with all deliberate speed to locate and stop any infiltration and inflow in the sewer lines of the Goodlettsville Sewer System. Long seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 12:21pm.
