

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Fred Schott. Minutes of the April 5 meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance No. 90-425, an ordinance to amend Title 11, Chapters 6, 9, 11, and 14 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code (Ordinance No. 89-413, as amended) by changing, adding, and deleting various provisions of the zoning ordinance. Third reading. Motion by Long to pass on third reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Consider a resolution requesting Madison Suburban Utility District to increase the deposit for commercial sewer service. The City Manager stated that the resolution sets the non-residential sewer deposit at \$100. Motion by Filson to adopt Resolution No. R90-104. Seconded by Long. Adopted unanimously.

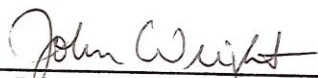
The City Manager reported on proposed programs for recycling. A speaker was unable to attend and will be on the agenda for the next meeting. However, the City has taken steps to get a recycling program underway within the next thirty days. Residents will be able to drop off recyclable materials at the Public Works Department.

Consider recommendation from Planning & Zoning Board to accept public improvements for Charleston Square Subdivision, Section 4. The City Planner explained the procedure established by the new subdivision regulations whereby a developer must meet certain conditions required by the Planning Board which then recommends that the Commission adopt a resolution of acceptance of public facilities. Motion by Garrett that the item be deferred until the City Attorney has reviewed the resolution since this is the first time that it has come before the Commission. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Consider request to transfer funds. The City Manager requested that \$4500 be transferred from Legal & Professional (415,35) to Attorney Retainer (415,12). The Police Chief requested that \$10000 be transferred from Salaries (421,20); \$2000 from Overtime (421,25); \$3000 from Maintenance (421,60); \$2200 from Legal Advisor (421,17); \$15000 to Car Expense (421,30); \$700 to Training (421,40); \$1500 to Telephone (421,51). The Fire Captain requested that \$17000 be transferred from Fire Calls (422,45); \$5000 to Overtime (422,25); \$5000 to Supplies (422,50); \$5000 to Maintenance (422,60); \$1000 to Water (422,62); \$1000 to Gas (422,63). Motion by Garrett to approve the transfers. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

The City Manager commended all the departments involved in the evacuation and housing of the children at La Petite Day Care following a gas leak today.

The meeting adjourned at 6:54pm.
