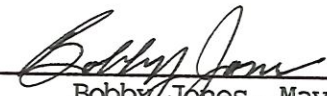

The City Attorney was to report on changes to the City Manager-Commission Charter enacted by the last legislature. He suggested that highlights be written in a memo for consideration by the commissioners. Childers moved that this be done and this item be put on the agenda for the next meeting. Long seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Billy Benz, a resident on Old Springfield Highway, expressed concern over the proposed subdivision adjacent to his property just outside the city limits. He requested that the City purchase the property for use as a park. The Mayor stated that the commission was already considering the matter.
