The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Johnny Long. Minutes of the January 4 meeting were approved as written.

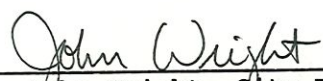
Consider amendment to Title 2, Chapter 2, Section 2-211 of the Municipal Code regarding minimum distance from dwellings for qualifications for a beer permit. Motion by Filson to pass an ordinance clarifying the distance requirement. Seconded by Long. Ordinance No. 90-422 passed unanimously on caption on first reading.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 90-421, an ordinance to amend Title 10, Chapter 2, Section 10-214-d of the Municipal Code regarding discharge of firearms within the City. The City Manager pointed out that the minimum of five acres may be too small in some cases and that further study is needed. Motion by Garrett to defer this ordinance for further study. Seconded by Long. Motion to defer passed unanimously.

Hear report from the City Attorney regarding agreement with Tennessee Department of Transportation involving an emergency ramp to I-65 from Alta Loma Road. John Cannon reported that the Metro Council has approved the agreement but the documents have not been signed. Motion by Long to approve the agreement. Seconded by Filson. Passed unanimously.

The City Manager and the City Planner presented information and slides regarding the adverse impact of the Hendersonville By-pass on some of the property owners on Draper Circle. It was agreed that several landscape contractors would be contacted for ideas and estimates to provide effective screening vegetation.

The meeting adjourned at 6:55pm.
