The meeting was called to order by Chairman Eddie Niebruegge. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as written.

Appeals Case No. (90-194) To consider the request of George Vogt, of Swaney and Vogt, for Dominion Bank, for a variance in Section 11-902(i) Off-Street Parking Lot Design Standards, of the Zoning Ordinance.

Terry stated the item was on the agenda at the April meeting and was deferred at that time and that the city engineers have since discussed the thirty degree angle parking requirements and decided they should remain the same. Items such as this should be handled by the board since this type parking is not commonly used. On a motion by Tongate, seconded by Jackson the board voted unanimously to adopt the following resolution,

WHEREAS, this is not a commonly used parking design and;

WHEREAS, there is not a cross parking agreement with the Plaza and the bank will comply with adequate parking spaces and;

WHEREAS, the design meets the requirements of standard parking lot design manuals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a variance in the aisle width of thirty degree angle parking be granted for an aisle width of thirteen feet and eight inches.
