Unfinished Business

LPRF/Rachel's Garden Playground: At the last commissioners' meeting, the commission approved the LPRF contract. Beginning August 15th we can begin putting the work out to bid. We couldn't move any dirt until this contract was signed, now that it's signed things will begin to move quickly.

Pickleball Courts: The pickleball courts are now paved. Currently have the coating of the courts out for bid. Coating of courts will happen all at one time, hoping to have it done pretty quickly.

We have a group of people that have really tried to grow pickleball in Goodlettsville. Hoping to have the courts done soon to accommodate the growing interest. Continuing to work with Chris Taylor to offer more pickleball clinics.

Aquatics: We have someone who is looking into our master plan to get a rough estimate of what it would look like to add-on an aquatics facility to the community center. Also, still looking for old plans that were drawn up for an aquatics facility. Goal is to have a presentation in September from Kimberly Horn.

Parks and Recreation Month: Since beginning the We Rise Up campaign to offer free programming in July, we've seen an increase in daily participants as people have been introduced to our offerings. We hope to retain some of the new customers once we go back to

regular pricing.

Planning to have a health and wellness month offer in January to bring in more participants.

New Business

Halloween in the Park: Halloween in the park will be on October 22nd this year. It will fall on the same day as tourism hosts their Goodfest and Fall Market. Combining forces since we use a lot of city resources for these events. Also hoping to minimize the impact on athletics by combining these offerings. Still looking for booth and activity sponsors for Halloween in the park.
