Approval of Minutes

After a review of the minutes from the September 27th, 2022 meeting, a motion was made to approve the minutes by Lori Cordell.

Reports from Staff- Reports were given by Superintendent of Parks, Jack Presley, and Superintendent of Recreation, Jennifer Spillers.

Unfinished Business

LPRF/Rachel's Garden Playground- We are fully contracted with LPRF and will attend a workshop on December 12th to learn the next steps. The state is requiring us to go out to bid for the playground in the coming months. We will begin advertising for those bid specs soon. Kimley Horn is currently surveying the land. Hopeful to start seeing movement soon.

Pickleball Courts- Used ARPA funds to update fencing, which changed the final coating timeline. The fencing is now complete. Need surface temperatures to be at 50 degrees to place the coating, so weather will be a big factor in completing the courts. The contractor is looking out for the city by taking his time to ensure that the coating lasts. We have all the hardware and nets in storage and will be ready to install once the coating is down. Pickleball is growing, all introductory classes are selling out, the courts will be a welcome addition for players once completed.

Volleyball Courts- Construction began on November 7th. Piping has been laid on the first 3 courts, drainage and gravel is down and then a layer of fabric. Sand has been delivered. Timeline of December 5th for completion. Portions of the park will be closed for the safety of patrons as construction continues. Working on fees that will be presented to the commissioners for renting the facility.

Aquatics Feasibility Study- Put out a bid and received four offers for studies. We have selected a company and hope that after the first of year we can bring them in and they can present a plan to the parks board. The process in the proposal we selected said it would take 6 months to survey the community and create a plan that would be beneficial to the community.

Dog Park Dash Grant- The expanded fencing has been installed. Signage has been ordered that will be here after the beginning of the year. Shade structures have also been ordered. Once everything is in, we'll have them installed and have a small grand reopening of the dog park.

New Business

City Website- City is going through a revamp of the website. We are trying to get more information out to the community. A new portion of the website is a projects update page, <https://www.goodlettsville.gov/1049/Park-Facility-Projects>. On that page you can see where we're at with the dog park, pickleball courts, and volleyball courts. We will update the webpage anytime there is a project update.

Also, a special events button has been added on the main page of the cities' website, next to the calendar. It's a one-stop shop to see all city-wide events.

Comments from Board Members & Staff- Congratulations were offered to Jimmy Anderson on his reelection as city commissioner.
