Chairman Jerry Mayes called the meeting to order. Richard Pope made a motion to approve the minutes of the 07/13/2022 meeting minutes, seconded by Jennifer Duncan, approved 5-0.

No citizen comments.

City comments: Corrected City Manager-Amended

Old business. S & S Promotions, LLC DBA Patron Event Center located at 709 Rivergate Pkwy. Goodlettsville: TN 37072 has requested a permit for an on-premises sale of Beer for their Event Venue/Restaurant. S & S Promotions Attorney, Jenna attends with two owners, Salinas and Silva.

City Attorney Russell Freeman questions catering and feels this is a good fit, there would be no dual permit for restaurant and catering, it would just be the one.

Addam with codes went out to visit the event center and mentioned more exit doors, 1,000 people would be the occupancy, was 700. Discussed what all happened through the walk through.

Mr. Ellis mentions how they have been on site twice and were very cooperative with the process.

S&S Attorney Jenna mentions they intend to host events at the event center and has good intentions and are very community drives, she mentions other community events that the owners have done and intend to do going forward. Richard Pope questions security. Mentions and questions whether their will be check points at the door, who will they hire to do this, Metro? Goodlettsville? Making sure bartenders and servers will be licensed and checking ID's. S & S confirms that they will be using Metro Police for security and all bartenders are licensed and servers will be checking IDs.

Mr. Ellis reminds S & S that the building is for sale that they have a lease with, saying that this is for catering only, if anything changes, they cannot operate without a new license. He proceeds to explain our code and that they could lose the permit if those rules were broken.

Harry Bell asks if they will be open any other time besides for events, they explain that at this time, it would be for events only. Richard Pope asks about the Health Department permit pending.

Questions about food percentage from Harry Bell, City Attorney explains percentage of food to revenue, but since this is a catering hall, there would be none of that. Discussion about an approval for the permit for on-premise beer permit is approved, as long as S & S Promotions bring in the Health Department Permit to City Hall once it is received.

No New business:

Richard Pope made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jennifer Duncan the board voted 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:25 a.m.
