Chairman Jerry Mayes called the meeting to order. Jennifer Duncan made a motion to approve the minutes of the 06/08/2022 meeting minutes, seconded by Richard Pope, approved 2-0.

No citizen comments.

City comments: Mr. Ellis, City Manager, notifies the board of changes in the code and how they can access it with a new

Old business. S & S Promotions, LLC DBA Patron Event Center located at 709 Rivergate Pkwy. Goodlettsville: TN 37072 has requested a permit for an on-premises sale of Beer for their Event Venue/Restaurant. The owners of S & S Promotions explain their venue to be consisted of concerts, weddings, parties, and special events.

They plan to be open to the public Thursday-Sunday, if they do not have any events for those days. They provided a menu that would be served to the public as well as letting the board know that no outside food would be brought in, they could purchase food from their kitchen or other restaurants owned by the owners. Richard Pope questions the food provided and asks if they plan on having a licensed bartender, which both owners confirm that they would.

City Attorney Russell Freeman questions classification for the event space being a restaurant or a catering hall. He and Mr. Ellis explain concerns and requirements for both permits and with the TCA code. Mr. Ellis says it could be a dual classification as they will be providing both services.

Mr. Ellis proceeds with questions on the criminal histories of both owners. Mr. Silva was caught with a gun without a gun permit in 1998 but has since received his carry permit and only served 9-month probation period. Mr. Salinas was only stopped on traffic violations.

Mr. Ellis proceeds to explain, with help from City Attorney that special events that cause restaurants to close, not allowing it to be open to the public at least 3 days a week, will be in violation of the code. He asks that the board consider hearing this again in a month and defer the permit at this time, as the business owners of S & S Promotions come up with a business plan for clarification. He also calls Mike Bauer up to introduce to the business and explains they need to get with him, as he is the code and fire marshal to meet those guidelines and have record of the exit plan in case of emergency.

S&S is to meet again in a month on August 10th, 2022 after listing specification on how they plan to run the business. City Attorney as for clarification and informs them of each permit and what they each require receiving a license. They will pick up the questions the board and City need clarification on, Friday July 15th

and will need to turn these business operation plan back to the City by lunch Friday July, 22nd to be heard by the 10th of August.

Mr. Jerry Mayes asks if heard a motion to defer S & S Promotions, LLC another month, Richard Pope makes a motion to approve, seconded by Jennifer Duncan, board voted, approved 2-0.

No New business:

Richard Pope made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jennifer Duncan the board voted 2-0.
