Chairman Jerry Mayes called the meeting to order. Richard Pope made a motion to approve the minutes of the 02/09/2022 meeting minutes, seconded by Jennifer Duncan, approved 3-0.

Jerry Mayes presents the new election for Chairperson and Vice Chair. Richard Pope nominates Jerry Mayes to remain Chair. Motion to approve by Jennifer Duncan and seconded by Doug Mullican, approved 3-0. Doug Mullican then proceeds to nominate Jennifer Duncan as Vice Chairperson, proceeded with a motion to approve by Doug Mullican, seconded by Richard Pope, approved 3-0.

New business: S & S Promotions, LLC DBA Patron Event Center located at 709 Rivergate Pkwy. Goodlettsville: TN 37072 has requested a permit for an on-premises sale of Beer for their Event Venue. Mr. Salinas stated that this Event Center would hold concerts, weddings, and other events. Mr. Ellis asks that City Attorney Russell Freeman to swear in the applicants, when noticing only one applicant showed up, issues arose about the appearance of both applicants and that we could not give a beer permit to them until they could question both parties since this is a partnership.

City Manager mentions concerns about the criminal history of Mr. Silva and wanted to reschedule because of those concerns as well as his questions on selling food since the law states that if you are to sell beer there must be revenue showing food sales as well. City Attorney also questions if they would classify as a catering company, so they could do events, but food would have to be served. Richard Pope questions the event center as to what they were wanting to do food and alcohol for, Mr. Salinas explains that they would have a licensed bartender serve the beer and they would order food from another vendor to serve. City Manager mentions again that until other partner is present that the decision could not be made at this time.

Larry Diorio makes a clarification that the plans state 1100 occupants with no tables is what is allowed in the building, but when having events and putting in table and chairs, this changes those plans. For every new event the center would have they would have to have new plans for the set up and how many people would be able to fit due to life safety precautions. If there were 80 seats, they could obtain the beer permit. City Manager suggest that we revisit in a month, to have the other partner present for questioning and to finalize a menu or plan for food and reschedule the meeting for 1 month. Jennifer Duncan makes a motion to defer and is seconded by Richard Pope, the board voted to defer another month for revisions, approved 3-0.

Richard Pope made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jennifer Duncan the board voted 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:15 a.m.
