Chairman Harry Bell called the meeting to order. Mr. Jerry Mayes made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 11th meeting, seconded by Mr. Ernest Denson, approved 5-0.

No citizen comments.

Old business: Mr. Keith Zust, part owner, represented PitchFork Pizza, LLC located at 401 Long Hollow pike, Ste. 100, Goodlettsville, TN 37072. Mr. Zust stated they were excited to finally be opening July 14th and having a family and friends' night the 10th and 11th before the grand opening. They have been approved and received all permits required for opening. Mr. Mayes made a motion to approve the on-premises permit for Pitchfork Pizza, seconded by Mr. Denson the board voted 5-0 to approve the permit.

New business: Mrs. Lori Blair with Blair, Inc. DBA Big Shakes Nashville Hot Chicken located at 720 Rivergate Pkwy. Ste. B, Goodlettsville, TN 37072. They are now under new ownership and requesting a new beer permit. City Attorney Russell Freeman pointed out that her corporation "Blair, Inc" was not registered with the State of Tennessee as of this morning and that would need to be done before license would be approved. City Manager Tim Ellis allows the license to be approved per the board on contingent that she has the Alabama License transferred to Tennessee in the next two days or permit will not be granted. Mr. Ellis also inquired about the live music that had been discussed previously, saying that code and planning would need to be aware and correct steps should be taken. Board members approve of that contingent offer. Mr. Denson made the motion to approve Big Shakes, seconded by Mr. Mayes the board voted 5-0 to approve contingent offer.

New business: Mr. Tayo Atanna, legal counsel for Cracker Barrel at Waller Lansden Dortch and Davis, Cracker Barrel Country Store #33 has requested to sell an on-premise Beer License. They confirmed their hours of operation were 7 a.m-9 p.m. S-T 7 a.m.- 10 p.m. F/S. They also stated no beer or wine will be sold off premises at this time. Board Member Mr. Mayes asked if this was going to be state wide for all Cracker Barrel's and Mr. Tayo responded that he did not know at this time. Mr. Mayes made a motion to approve the on-premise permit for Cracker Barrel #33, seconded by Mr. Denson the board voted 5-0 to approve the permit.

Mr. Denson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Mayes the board voted 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:17.
