Approval of Minutes

After a review of the minutes from the May 21, 2024 meeting, a motion was made to approve the minutes by Stuart Huffman.

Reports from Staff – Reports were given by the Superintendent of Parks, Jack Presley, and the Superintendent of Recreation, Jennifer Spillers.

Unfinished Business-

Volleyball Project- The original vendor booked for the project has become unresponsive. A second vendor has been secured, and this project is next on their list. A sidewalk will be added from the parking lot to the courts, and a concrete pad to hold bleachers. The bleachers are being repurposed from the Community Center gym.

LPRF- Rachel's Garden- The playground equipment has been ordered. It will be custom manufactured and will be shipped in November. There is an upcoming bid for construction of the playground, along with making needed improvements to the sidewalks and parking lot. The bid opening date is August 23rd.

Disc Golf Course- The signage for the golf course is currently being ordered. Once completed a ribbon cutting ceremony will be scheduled.

Aquatics Update- Pool admissions have increased in numbers over this time last year. The pool closes for the season on August 3rd, 2024. A more thorough report of revenue earned will be provided at the next parks board meeting.

New Business

2024-2025 Capital Purchasing- A report was provided to the board that showed the approved capital spending requests. The budgeted amount for each item and the progress on the purchases was provided in the report.

Comments from Board Members & Staff- Accolades were given to the parks staff for their hard work by Mrs. Jennings, Commissioner Huffman, and Mr. Kelly.
Mr. Ellis introduced Sean Pfizer who is doing a fellowship with the City of Goodlettsville.
