

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE BEER BOARD**

Date: July 11, 2006
Time: 4:00 PM
Place: City Hall Auditorium

Board members present were Chairman Randall Hall, Walter Slater, Karl Nixon, Jack Hunnicutt and Mark Allison. City staff members present were City Manager Jim Thomas, City Recorder Claudia Davis and Deputy Chief Richard Pope. Also present was Steven C. Sanders of Jakes Mountain Grill, Ming Yun Dong and his son of Blue Sky Buffet, and Jennifer Boyd of Bailey's..

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Randall Hall.

A motion was made by Walter Slater to approve the minutes of the April 11 2006 meeting as submitted. The motion was seconded by Jack Hunnicutt and passed unanimously 5-0.

Consider request of Jakes MG, LLC, Jakes Mountain Grill, 909 Rivergate Parkway, for an on premises permit. Steven C. Sanders stated he is a majority owner in this corporation and partial owner of the real estate. This is a new restaurant offering an affordable menu with seating downsized to 184 to better accommodate the parking on this site. They plan to open the restaurant on August 7th. Deputy Chief Pope stated the records report was clear. A motion was made by Karl Nixon to approve an on premises beer permit to Jakes MG, LLC. The motion was seconded by Jack Hunnicutt and passed unanimously 5-0.

Consider request of Ming Yun Dong for an on premises permit for Blue Sky Buffet, 900 Conference Drive, Suite 11. Mr. Dong's son stated his father does not speak English. He is the new owner of the Blue Sky Buffet and requests approval for a beer permit. All the records from the application were in order. A motion was made by Walter Slater to approve an on premises permit to Mr. Dong. The motion was seconded by Jack Hunnicutt and passed unanimously 5-0.

Jennifer Boyd, General Manager for Bailey's Bar and Grill, 786 Rivergate Parkway, requested permission to hold a special event on July 14th in their parking lot. The tented area for the event will be cordoned off by a fence. There will be private protection security personnel attending the only entrance into the tent area. The only alcohol served in the tent will be Budweiser draft from a Budweiser truck and contained within the fence around the tent. Parking will be available to the left and right of the tent and also in the NTB parking lot. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times. They have obtained permission from all the business owners in the complex. The event will be from 5:00 p.m. till 1:00 a.m. There will be music played from the Budweiser Book Box but they will be considerate of the volume after 10:00 p.m. A motion was made by Karl

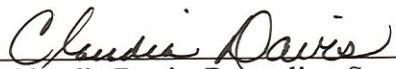
Nixon to authorize permission for this special event. The motion was seconded by Jack Hunnicutt and passed 5-0.

Jim Thomas stated after the agenda for this meeting had been published, the General Manager of Hooter's requested permission to conduct a weekly outdoor event exactly like they had in 2005 which was permitted by the Beer Board. A motion was made by Jack Hunnicutt to allow the City Manager to review the conditions of the event and if they are exactly as was carried out last year, to approve this request. The motion was seconded by Mark Allison and passed unanimously 5-0.

Deputy Chief Richard Pole reported that NCIC no longer allows records checks on applicants for beer permits. He recommended using the services of the TBI to obtain the records check. A motion was made by Mark Allison to require applicants to obtain a records check from the TBI or the state where they are from, at their expense. The motion was seconded by Jack Hunnicutt and passed unanimously 5-0.

Jim Thomas informed the board members that the application fee for a beer permit was increased from \$250 to \$500 effective July 1, 2006.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:25 p.m.
