

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE BEER BOARD**

Date: September 6, 2005
Time: 4:00 PM
Place: City Hall Auditorium

Board members present were Chairman Walter Slater, Randall Hall, Jack Hunnicutt and Karl Nixon. Board member Mark Allison was absent. City staff members present were City Manager Jim Thomas and City Recorder Claudia Davis. Others present were Melony Houston, Store Manager for Eckerd's and Suleyman Hamzapour, owner of Two Mile Market.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Walter Slater.

Consider request of Dennis K. Bethuy of Chase's Pool-Sports-Music, 900 Conference Drive, Suite 7, for an on premises permit. Randall Hall reported that he had visited this location and the petitioner's facility does not yet meet the requirements to issue a beer permit. City Manager Thomas reported that due to several delays due to a number of reasons and circumstances, this request has been deferred more than once. He suggested and the board unanimously agreed to allow the staff to issue a temporary permit to Mr. Bethuy when he presents a use and occupancy codes permit and a license to serve food from the health department authorities. The petition for a permanent beer license would then be heard at the October 11, 2005 regular beer board meeting.

City Manager Thomas asked the board to consider action for a violation of the beer ordinance that occurred at Eckerd Drugs #2620 at 116 South Main Street on June 23, 2005, selling beer to a person less than twenty-one years of age. He reviewed the prior history of violations at this store. On June 16, 2004, they were fined \$300 for a violation that occurred on March 15, 2004. There were also three prior violations in 2003 that were not heard by the beer board. Melony Houston, Store Manager, indicated the clerk had just turned 18 years old. They have prompts on their cash register's, but apparently he was excited and didn't understand. He looked at the identification and then sold the beer to the minor. His employment was terminated that day. Their employees are trained on their date of hire and they are required to sign a form acknowledging their responsibility in selling beer. Karl Nixon made a motion to impose a fine of \$500 with no suspension on the permit because the employee was immediately dismissed. The motion was seconded by Randall Hall and passed unanimously 4-0. Ms. Houston was instructed that the fine must be paid by 4:30 p.m. on September 13, 2005.

City Manager Thomas asked the board to consider action for a violation of the beer ordinance that occurred at Mapco Express at 301 Long Hollow Pike on June 23, 2005, selling beer to a person less than twenty-one years of age. He indicated this is the first offense at this location. There was no representative present from Mapco. Karl Nixon made a motion to impose a fine of \$500 with no suspension on the permit. The motion was seconded by Jack Hunnicutt and passed unanimously 4-0. Thomas suggested to

allow two additional days for mailing a notice of the fine imposed, and that the fine be due by 4:30 p.m. on September 15, 2005.

City Manager Thomas asked the board to consider action for a violation of the beer ordinance that occurred at Two Mile Market at 106 Rivergate Parkway on June 23, 2005, selling beer to a person less than twenty-one years of age. Suleyman Hamzapour, owner of the business, stated that business was very slow and he only had the business open for a few weeks. It was during that time that the violation occurred. Karl Nixon made a motion to not impose a fine. The motion was seconded by Jack Hunnicutt and passed unanimously 4-0.

Walter Slater stated he would like to remain on the beer board but that he would like to resign as Chairman. He recommended by way of a motion that Randall Hall serve as the Chairman going forward. The motion was seconded by Karl Nixon and approved unanimously 4-0. Randall Hall accepted the position.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:38 p.m.
