

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
GOODLETTSVILLE BEER BOARD**

Date: October 12, 2004

Time: 4:00 PM

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Walter Slater. The board and staff welcomed new board members Mark Allison and Randall Hall.

Thomas reported that the Goodlettsville Police conducted eight different undercover attempts to purchase beer by a minor on October 5th. The businesses that were visited were ones that have been recently cited for violations. Four of the purchases were in full compliance, but unfortunately, four of the attempts resulted in violations of the beer ordinance. These violations will be considered at the November meeting.

Thomas stated that this meeting was called to consider the request of Kirit Amrat Vanimali for an off-premises beer permit for R & S Citgo, 937 Louisville Highway. This application was submitted on September 30, 2004. As has been the practice of the City in the past, when a business is sold where there is an active beer permit and the business remains open, a temporary beer license was issued on October 1, 2004 to expire on October 13, 2004, after the application was submitted and a background check by the Police Department determined there were no issues on his record. While operating under the temporary permit, as a follow up to previous violations at this business, the Police Department conducted an attempt to purchase beer by a minor on October 5, 2004. The beer was sold to the minor and a citation was issued for violation of the beer ordinance. Mr. Vanimali stated he would make sure that this will not happen again. They purchased the store on October 1 and Simon, the clerk who made the sale, was a new employee. Vanimali pleaded with the board to issue the permanent license. A motion was made by Nixon to impose a \$500.00 fine and lock their coolers for a weekend for the violation while operating with the temporary permit. Duncan seconded the motion. Pope noted that previously, the board has not imposed a suspension on sales when the violation is a first offense. Nixon withdrew his motion. Nixon made a motion to impose a \$500.00 fine for the October 5, 2004 violation. Duncan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Nixon made a motion to grant a permanent beer permit to Kirit Amrat Vanimali. Hall seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Hall informed Vanimali that he must be very careful and impressed on him the seriousness of violations going forward. He stated that another violation will result in suspension of beer sales.

The next meeting will be November 9, 2004 at 4:00 p.m. Motion was made by Duncan to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 4:20 p.m.
