Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M. Minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

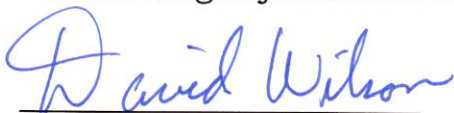
There were three items on the agenda:

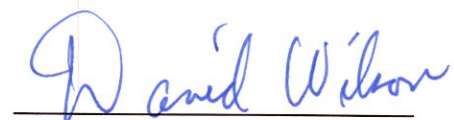
