The purpose of this meeting was to consider action regarding violations of the beer ordinance, selling beer to minors, by Zippy's Market, 858 Louisville Highway, Steven's Grocery, 309 North Main Street and Aztex #43, 150 Long Hollow Pike.

Capt. Richard Pope was present to make a report to the Board regarding the citations. He reported that on 9/27/94, the Goodlettsville Police Department conducted undercover beer purchases within the City. They went to all locations with off-premises permits with a 19 year old female with no identification. The three establishments named above were cited.

Walter Slater made a motion to suspend the permit of Zippy's market for a 48 hour period from noon Friday, February 17, 1995 to Sunday, February 19, 1995 with a 90 day probationary period. The motion was seconded by Roy Duncan and unanimously approved.

Roy Duncan made a motion to suspend the permit of Steven's Grocery for the next two consecutive week-ends for a 48 hour period with 6 months probation. The motion was seconded by Walter Slater and unanimously approved.

Roy Duncan moved to suspend the permit of Aztex #43 for the next two consecutive week-ends for a 48 hour period with 6 months probation. The motion was seconded by Walter Slater and unanimously approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:30 P. M.
