She was cited by Detective Harold Willis.

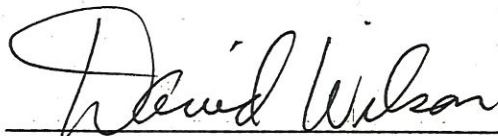

James Smith made a motion to suspend the beer permit at this location for a period of 48 hours and to place the establishment under 30 days probation. The permit is to be suspended from noon July 16, 1993, to noon Sunday, July 18, 1993.

Roy Duncan seconded the motion which was unanimously adopted.
