Chairman Denton called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M.

The City Manager explained to the Board that Thomas Wright had made application for an off-premises beer permit for Music City North Truck Stop at 956 Louisville Highway. This location has been closed for several months, but has been leased and will be re-opened by Mr. Wright. Mr. Wright did not get his application in on time to be advertised on the February agenda for the Board meeting. He is asking at this time for a temporary permit to allow him to open his business approximately February 20, 1992. He would then be on the advertised agenda for the March Board meeting to apply for his regular permit. The City Manager reported to the Board that Mr. Wright had no problems on his background check by the Police Department and recommended the temporary permit be issued. On a motion by Smith, seconded by Duncan and unanimously approved, Mr. Wright's temporary permit was granted through March 10, 1992.

The two items on the agenda were for off-premises permit applications by new managers: 1) Mildred W. Jackson at Aztex #43, 150 Long Hollow Pike; and, 2) Robert D. Rickman, new owner of Rickman's Raceway Market (formerly Raceway Food Mart), 943 Louisville Highway. The City Manager reported that neither of these applications had any problems on their background check. On a motion by Duncan, seconded by Smith, both permits were unanimously approved.

The meeting adjourned at 5:20 P.M.
