The Cooker at 317 Bluebird Drive

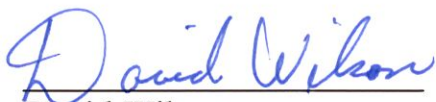
The Chairman then asked if there were any repeat offenders from last year. There were two, Kirb Market and Mapco/Delta. The Chairman then asked for any recommendation from Lt. Bell as to action the Board might take. Lt. Bell recommended the Board be consistent and use the 48 hour suspension. The Chairman then asked for comments from the permit holders who were cited.
