Chairman Denton called the meeting to order. Minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

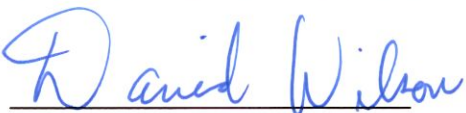
This meeting was a special called meeting to consider the request of Mike Patton and Pat Patton, owners of T. Michael's/Laredo's, for re-instatement of their on-premises permit which was suspended by the Board at the October 8, 1991 regular meeting.

City Manager David Wilson gave a background of the concerns and problems regarding this establishment over some period of time. This involved lack of cooperation with the City on changes at the business, certain code violations, no building permit obtained for structural changes, concern for under age persons being present where alcoholic beverages were being sold, security concerns, etc.

The Chairman asked Mike Patton to explain the status of their operation and their plans for the future. Mr. Patton explained that they planned to re-open as a restaurant and entertainment club for adults, and that, at this time, had no plans to open any nights as an underage club. If they do plan to do that, they will come back before the Board with their plans.

After discussion, Denton moved to re-instate the on-premises permit for T. Michael's. the motion was seconded by Roy Duncan. On discussion of the motion, Smith expressed his strong concern regarding the lack of cooperation on the part of the owners and management of this business, and said he did not feel their permit should be re-instated. On a vote on the motion, Denton and Duncan voted aye, Smith voted no.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:45 P.M.
