Chairman Denton called the meeting to order. Minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Discussion occurred regarding the status of the on-premises beer permit at T. Michael's, 709 Two Mile Parkway. Concern about this permit had been expressed by the Board at its May 21, 1991 meeting which was continued by the Chairman until advice could be obtained from the City Attorney regarding appropriate action on the continuance of this permit.

It was the Chairman's decision to continue the May 21st meeting at this time, and after further reports of the lack of cooperation on the part of management of T. Michael's/Loredo's, Smith made a motion to suspend the on-premises permit immediately. The motion was seconded by Roy Duncan and unanimously approved. The City Manager was asked to inform Thomas M. Patton of the Board's action as soon as feasible.

At this time, the agenda for the meeting scheduled for this date was considered. The only item was to consider the request of Lora Darbashi, manager of B.P. Oil, 711 Two Mile Parkway, for an off-premises permit. There being no problem on her background check, Smith made a motion to approve the permit, seconded by Roy Duncan and unanimously approved. Ms. Barbashi is the new manager of this business after Jasser Yasser Mahmoud's request for a permit was deferred at the September 10, 1991 meeting due to the fact he was not yet a citizen of the U.S. It was reported that Mr. Mahmoud did become a citizen on 9/18/91.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:25 P.M.
