Chairman Denton called the meeting to order. Minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

The first item on the agenda was to consider the request of Clint McMillin, manager of R&N Market, 106 Two Mile Parkway, for an off-premises permit. This matter had been considered at the previous Beer Board meeting as a request for Rajesh Patel, an owner of the market who is not a US citizen. The request was deferred for a legal opinion from the City Attorney. The City Attorney rendered an opinion that the ordinance is constitutional in requiring US citizenship for a beer permit. On a motion by Denton, seconded by Smith and unanimously approved, the permit was denied on advice of the City Attorney.

Item two was to consider the request of Ernest Sorrell, new manager of BP Oil, 711 Two Mile Parkway, for an off-premises permit. On a motion by Smith seconded by Denton and unanimously approved, the permit was granted.

Item three was to consider the request of David Stephenson, new manager of Mr. Gatti's, 801 Two Mile Parkway, for an on-premises permit. On a motion by Smith, seconded by Denton and unanimously approved, the permit was granted.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:15 P.M.
