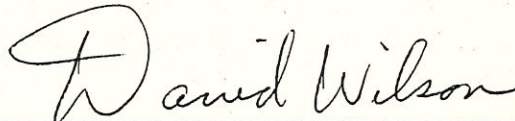

Item 3 was the request of Donald Swift for an off-premises permit at BP Oil, 711 Two Mile Parkway. In checking Mr. Swift's background, his record indicated a conviction in 1983 for burglary, forced entry of a non-residence for which he was placed on three years probation. After discussion of this crime, Jim Denton moved to defer action until next meeting to obtain a legal opinion from the City Attorney as to whether this crime is one of moral turpitude, as prohibited in the Beer Ordinance. Roy Duncan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Item 4 was to consider the request of William Richard Stinson, Jr., manager of Mr. Gatti's, 801 Two Mile Parkway, for an on-premises permit. On a motion by Jim Denton, seconded by James Smith, this permit was unanimously granted.

The meeting adjourned at 6:00 P.M.

Chairman Denton called the meeting to order. Minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Item one on the agenda was to consider action to be taken with regard to a citation for selling beer to a minor given to Second Win, 511 Two Mile Parkway. Roy Duncan made a motion to suspend their permit for 48 hours beginning at noon of Friday, October 12, 1990 to noon Sunday, October 14, 1990. Also to place the permit holder on 90 days probation beginning at noon on October 14. Smith seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Item two was to consider the request of Donald Swift, new manager of BP Oil, 711 Two Mile Parkway, for an off-premises permit. Given the report regarding Mr. Swift's background presented at the September 11, 1990 meeting, Denton moved to deny the permit, seconded by Smith and unanimously approved.

Item three was to consider the request of Richard Handley, new manager of Mapco-Delta Express, 301 Long Hollow Pike, for an off premises permit. Smith made a motion to approve the request, seconded by Denton and unanimously approved.

Item four was to consider the request of Rajesh D. Patel, new owner of R&N Market, formerly Bruce Brothers Market, 106 Two Mile Parkway, for an off-premises permit. Mr. Patel had indicated on his application that he was not a citizen of the US. Denton moved to defer action until next meeting to get a legal opinion from the City Attorney regarding the legality of US citizenship requirement in the beer ordinance to qualify for a permit. He also moved to grant a temporary permit until the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Duncan and unanimously approved.
