The meeting was called to order at 5:05 P.M. by Chairman Jim Denton. Prior to considering the applicants for permits on the agenda, the Board discussed the recent citations given to several holders of beer permits for selling beer to a minor. These cases were heard in City Court on August 28, 1990, before City Judge Rob Wheeler. Of the eleven cases, two had paid a \$50.00 fine prior to Court. Eight either pleaded or were found guilty and fined \$25.00 plus cost. Second Win at 511 Two Mile Parkway had their case continued until September 25, 1990.

After discussion and input from Captain Richard Pope, Goodlettsville Police Department, and the City Manager, on a motion by James Smith, seconded by Roy Duncan and unanimously approved, it was decided to place a 48-hour suspension on the permit of all those establishments whose cases had been disposed of in City Court, and to put each on a 90-day probationary period. The 48-hour suspension will begin at Noon on Friday, September 21, 1990, and extend to Noon on Sunday, September 23, 1990. The 90-day probationary period will begin at Noon on September 23, 1990. Any action against Second Win will be deferred until their case is heard in Court. The 48-hour suspension and probation involves the following locations:

- BP Oil, 254 Long Hollow Pike
- Bruce Brothers Market, 106 Two Mile Parkway
- Kirb Market, 845 Springfield Highway
- Kroger, 123 Northcreek Boulevard
- MAPCO-Delta Express, 301 Long Hollow Pike
- Pancho's, 654 Wade Circle
- Rivergate Texaco, 750 Two Mile Parkway
- R&R Market, 419 North Main Street
- Stevens Grocery, 309 North Main Street
- Rivergate Par Mart. 458 Moss Trail

Item No. 1 on the agenda was to consider the request of Kirby Clifton for an off-site permit at Kirb Market, 845 Springfield Highway. On a motion by Jim Denton, seconded by James Smith and unanimously adopted, this permit was approved.

Item 2 was to consider request of Shirley Helen Shouse of Mapco-Delta Express, 301 Long Hollow Pike, for an off-premises permit. On discussion, it was determined that Richard Handley,

who was present, was in fact the manager of this location. On a motion by James Smith, seconded by Roy Duncan and unanimously approved, it was decided to not grant this permit, but to issue a temporary permit in Richard Handley's name and have his application on the agenda for the October meeting for consideration for a permanent permit.

Item 5 was considered next. This was the request of Bradley Jon Horseman, manager of Ruby Tuesday, 1000 Two Mile Parkway, for an on-premises permit. On a motion by Roy Duncan, seconded by Jim Denton, this application was unanimously approved.

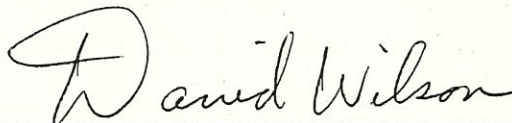
Item 3 was the request of Donald Swift for an off-premises permit at BP Oil, 711 Two Mile Parkway. In checking Mr. Swift's background, his record indicated a conviction in 1983 for burglary, forced entry of a non-residence for which he was placed on three years probation. After discussion of this crime, Jim Denton moved to defer action until next meeting to obtain a legal opinion from the City Attorney as to whether this crime is one of moral turpitude, as prohibited in the Beer Ordinance. Roy Duncan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Item 4 was to consider the request of William Richard Stinson, Jr., manager of Mr. Gatti's, 801 Two Mile Parkway, for an on-premises permit. On a motion by Jim Denton, seconded by James Smith, this permit was unanimously granted.

The meeting adjourned at 6:00 P.M.
