This ordinance the estbablishes distance restriction, square footage requirements and building type for all alternative financial facilities.

- d. Consider Resolution 15-631, a resolution authorizing the execution of an Inter-local agreement with the 18th Judicial District Drug and Violent Crime Task Force.

This resolution approves an agreement that allows the Goodlettsville Police Department to be a part of the 18th Judicial District Drug and Violent Crime Task Force.
