City comments: City Manager, Tim Ellis updated the board that another meeting regarding Caspers would be coming up soon within the next month or so anticipating new business within the City.

Violation of The City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 8, Chapter 2, Section 210, Subsection (1)(a), "Operates a disorderly place," requires each permittee to operate an orderly place of business.

City Manager states multiple calls for service over the last few months to the place of business for unruly behavior.

Chief Gary Goodwin informs board of two Aggravated Assault that occurred at the venue along with a cad report of multiple other call to the place of business over the past and showing the history of numerous fight calls, disorderly conduct as well as disturbance calls where police and fire were having to respond, on multiple different occasions. There was evidence of obvious overserving due to the call volume as well as vandalism involved in a domestic incident. The pattern was not getting resolved, but getting worse, which is why we called a meeting in hopes of getting this resolved. New General Manager of the business has reached out and tried to clean tis up and has a plan to get in a better standing withing the City.

The Attorney representing Fox and the Hound discusses the changes that needs to be made and outlines changes made withing the letter they provided.

City Attorney discusses culture change is needed. The GM of the Venue voices his plan to make changes within the restaurant. The board agreed to re-evaluate in four (4) months.

Mr. Harry Bell made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Vice Mayor Jennifer Duncan, the board voted 4-0. The meeting was adjourned at 9:24 a.m.
