7. Old Business.

- a. Consider Ordinance 15-829, an ordinance to amend Ordinance 06-674 as amended, the zoning ordinance of the City of Goodlettsville, by amending the INT Overlay District Map identified as I-65 Highway / 31-W in Goodlettsville, Tennessee.

This ordinance would remove two parcels of property from the interchange overlay district known as map & parcel number 026-09-0-038.0.

SECOND READING (DEFERRED FROM THE FEBRUARY 12, 2015 MEETING)

- b. Consider Ordinance 15-831, an ordinance to amend Title 8, Chapter 2, Section 206, Subsection 2(a) of the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code, by deleting subsection 2(a) in its entirety and replacing it with a new subsection 2(a).

This ordinance reduces the minimum seating capacity for on-premise and dual beer permits from 100 seats to 80. It also establishes certain criteria in determining seating capacity.

SECOND READING

- c. Consider Ordinance 15-832, an ordinance to amend Title 2, Chapter 1, Section 104, Subsection 4(a) of the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code, by deleting subsection 4(a) in its entirety and replacing it with a new subsection 4(a).

This ordinance would permit the consumption of alcohol at certain parks and recreation facilities during private and semi-private rented events.

SECOND READING

- d. Consider Ordinance 15-833, an ordinance to amend Title 5, Chapter 5, Section 503 of the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code, by deleting Section 503 in its entirety and replacing it with a new section 503.

This ordinance would eliminate the exemption of paying hotel motel tax to individuals staying in a hotel or motel for more than 90 consecutive days.

SECOND READING

8. New Business.

- a. Consider Resolution 15-618, a resolution of support for an application with the Federal Emergency Management Agency's "Staffing for Adequate Fire & Emergency Response" Grant Program.

This resolution acknowledges the City Commission's support for an application with FEMA for its Staffing for Adequate Fire & Emergency Response Grant Program. If awarded to the city it would allow for the employment of additional firefighters.

- b. Consider Resolution 15-619, a resolution establishing rules and regulations for the serving and consumption of alcohol within parks & recreation facilities as approved by Ordinance 15-832.

This resolution establishes the rules and regulations for the consumption of alcohol on parks & recreation facilities for private and semi-private events as approved by Ordinance 15-832.
