Updated Organizational Structure and Employee Introductions- Sarah Jennings announced the updated organizational structure between Parks, Recreation, and Public Works which has now become one department entitled Public Services. Josh Gaby and Dave Anderson were introduced and gave a brief summary of their role(s) within the Public Services Department.

2025 LPRF Grant- Sarah Jennings provided a map and announced that a grant was received in the amount of \$1.1 million for Phase 1 of a Moss Wright Park construction project to include traffic recirculation, additional walking trails and other improvements. Sarah is asking the Tree Advisory Board to consider ideas for tree planting and design suggestions for the grant project.

Adopt a Landscape - Project 072- A copy of "Project 072" was presented, and Sarah Jennings introduced the proposed Adopt-a-Landscape Program. The program would allow individuals or groups to adopt medians, islands, or park areas to provide supplemental maintenance of Goodlettsville's green spaces. As the project is in the early stages of development, the Tree Advisory Board may be consulted for planting recommendations. Julie Smith will lead the working group for this initiative.

Beautification Update- Allison Baker provided an update on the Beautification Project including progress in collaborating with Public Services on the early development stages and next steps to successfully implement both the Adopt-a-Street and Adopt-a-Landscape initiatives.

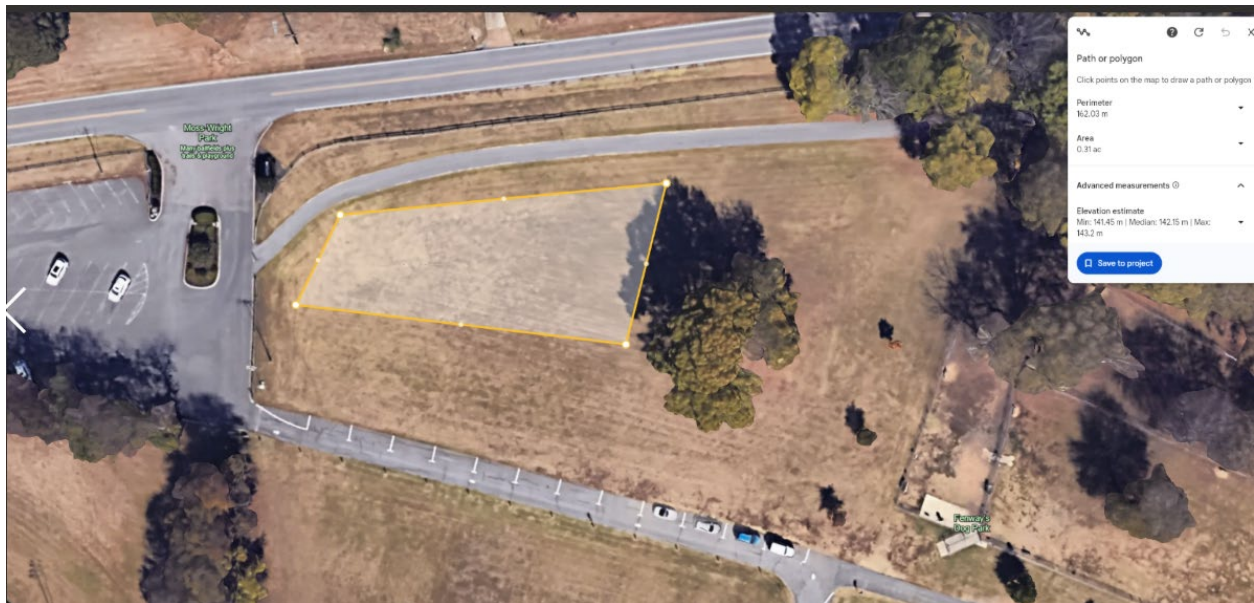
