Owner Joe Defao explains the venue will have food and live entertainment his kids are in the music business from Florida and he decided to create a space where they can do what they love in the city. No lunch currently, just dinner. Hours of business 4PM- 11PM. Date to open TBD. Questions on the Department of Revenue tax form, signature needed. Mr. Jerry Mayes makes a motion for approval, seconded by Vice Mayor Jennifer Duncan, the board voted 4-0.
- b. SHIV SAI Hospitality, GRP, INC DBA TRU Hilton 831 Conference Drive Goodlettsville, TN 37072 has requested a permit for an on-premise sale of Beer at their Hotel. Secretary and President introduce themselves and say their opening date is set for in September. Questions regarding background checks and ownership, corrections made to update the correct owners to the application. Clarification from the board was needed for the owners not being Hilton representatives and Hilton being the vendor. City Attorney clarified that

this had been brought up before and the DBA may be Hilton but the owners still oversee day to day operation.

Mr. Jerry Mayes made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Harry Bell, the board voted 4-0. The meeting was adjourned at 9:23 a.m.
