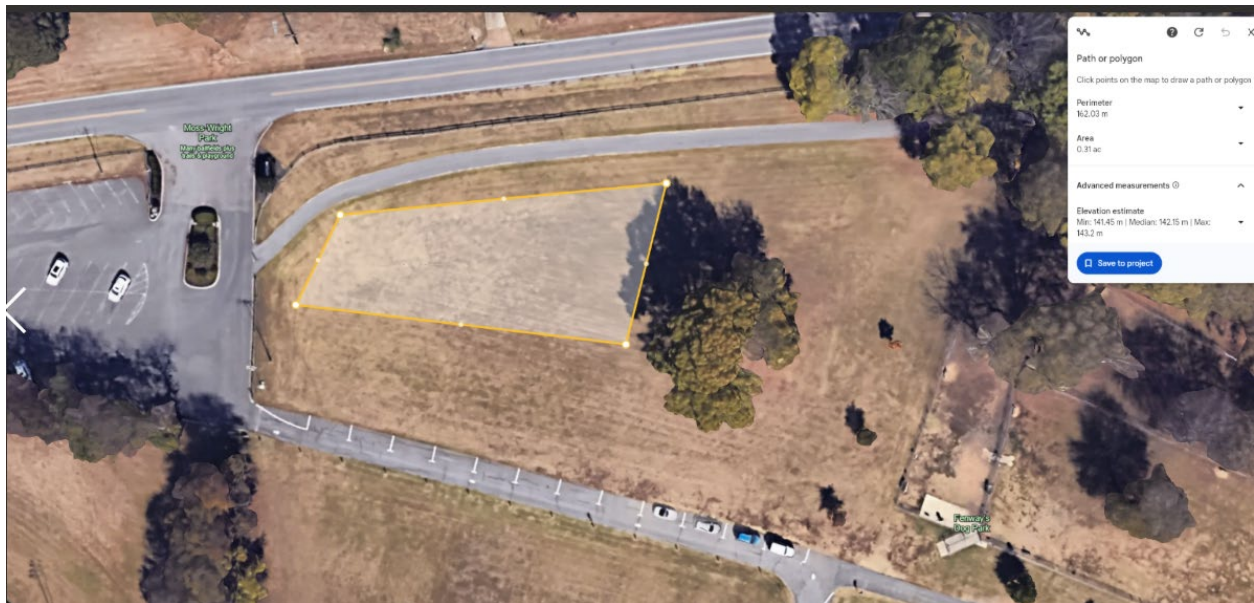
August: Spot spray + mow + remove thatch
