Consider Resolution 26-1346, a resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee, approving a Youth Sports Facility Use Agreement for the use of city-owned and city-managed athletic facilities by approved incorporated non-profit organizations and authorizing the City Manager to execute and administer such agreements.
- c. Consider Resolution 26-1350, a resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee, recognizing the month of September as Suicide Prevention Awareness Month.
