Vice Mayor Coombs announced that due to lack of a quorum, there would be a special called meeting on February 16, 2012 at 5:00 p.m. to hear the agenda items scheduled for this meeting.

There were several citizens present and he opened the floor for citizen comments at this time.

1. Gela Craig of 316 Melissa commended the police department. She stated that a friend who had served on a recent Grand Jury stated that the Goodlettsville officers were very professional, knowledgeable and very well prepared. She thanked Chief Pope and the police department for setting such a good example.
2. Mr. Hicks of Hanover Court (in Windsor Green) also commended the police department for always being very helpful and inquired about a bond for the Dial property of the Town Homes in Windsor Green.

City Manager Ellis stated that he would address the question. He stated that there was a bond that was called into question and the bonding company contested. We reached a solution to the matter. The City received around \$107,000 in bond money and the resolution he is referring to is earmarking the money for the issues needing improvements at Windsor Green.
