Vice Mayor Manning called the meeting to order. Rev. Bobby Webb offered prayer. Vice Mayor Manning led the chambers in the pledge of allegiance.

City Recorder Davis called the roll: Mayor Finch absent, Vice Mayor Manning present, Commissioner Garrett absent, Commissioner Coombs present, and Commissioner Bloodworth present.

Consider approval of the minutes of the regular Commission meeting on July 8, 2010. A motion was made by Commissioner Coombs to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bloodworth and passed unanimously 3-0.

Assistant City Manager Ellis reported that drainage repairs on Moss Trail will begin on Monday, July 26, 2010. While specific funding of this project is not identified in the budget, funding is available in the budget and this project is an allowable expenditure of state street aid funds.

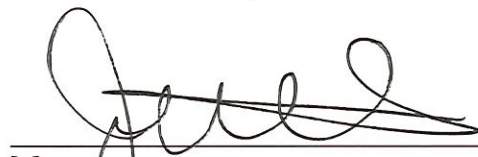
Public Works Director Brasier reported that one of the City's two chipper trucks is out of service due to a mechanical failure with the cutter drum. The repair cost is estimated at \$12,300 which is 28% of the equipment repair budget for the year. This is a twelve year old machine and \$10,000 was spent in March, 2010 to rebuild the truck. There is one chipper truck still operating but until the repair can be made on the second truck, it will be hard to maintain the six week chipper schedule. Commissioner Bloodworth inquired about outsourcing the chipper service and Brasier stated that there has been no further study on that issue. Commissioner Coombs asked that information about this equipment problem and the subsequent chipper service be put on the website to keep the citizens informed.

Consider Ordinance No. 10-746, an ordinance establishing a property tax rate for the fiscal year July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. City Manager Thomas stated the State requires the City to adopt a property tax rate each year. There is no increase in the tax rate from the previous year. A motion was made by Commissioner Coombs to approve Ordinance No. 10-746 on first reading. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bloodworth and passed unanimously 3-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:42 p.m.
