

with TDOT and there are no funds left in their contract. The Regional Construction Manager committed to watch for any funds that may become available.

Thomas reported in response to recent demand correspondence to delinquent business tax accounts, about 50% have paid and about 40 chose not to respond. The City Attorney has contacted these accounts with a June 10th deadline, at which time they will be turned over to General Sessions Court for action. He stated that all city personnel have been instructed to make no purchases from these businesses with any City funds.

Haynes congratulated Mayor Jones' grandson, eighth grader Austin Lee Bennett, who has been awarded the Gentleman Scholar Athletic Award at Montgomery Bell Academy. This is the highest honor a student can achieve at MBA.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jeff Jeffrey. Motion was made by Driver to approve the minutes of the May 27, 2004 regular meeting, seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

Consider Ordinance No. 04-645 adopting a budget and establishing a property tax rate for the fiscal year July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. The Mayor declared the public hearing open. No one spoke for or against the ordinance. The public hearing was closed. Motion was made by Cordell to approve Ordinance No. 04-645 on first reading, seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Garrett requested that his previous suggestion be reconsidered on the Commission agenda in March to appeal to TDOT to plant trees and landscaping in the median on Conference Drive.

Thomas encouraged participation in the Conference Drive promotion celebrating the completion of the road project, beginning Monday with a concert by Andy Griggs and will continue with daily activities for two weeks.

Thomas stated he is extremely pleased to announce that Julie High has accepted the position of Finance Director and will be coming to work on July 6th.

Joe Haynes stated that he felt the occasion of the recent celebration to honor the city's 150 year history was so special that he has sponsored a resolution in the state legislature. He read the resolution aloud and presented the document to Mayor Jones from the 103rd General Assembly.

Thomas announced that draft copies of the budget are available to the public during business hours at City Hall.
