

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jim Driver. Motion was made by Garrett, seconded by Driver, to approve the minutes of the October 9, 2003 regular meeting. Passed 3-0.

Consider Ordinance No. 03-638 an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 01-604, so that existing homeowners who purchase and move to another existing residence in the City will be exempt from a setup fee for trash pickup service. Motion was made by Driver to approve Ordinance No. 03-638 on second reading, seconded by Garrett. Passed 3-0.

Consider Resolution No. 03-268, a resolution to approve entering into a contract to prepare the "Goodlettsville Downtown Business District and Streetscape Plan". Wilson stated Bill Terry has been working for several years through the MPO for a grant to fund a study for a streetscape plan. The plan will cost \$35,000. \$25,000 will come from state funds and the City's part will be \$10,000 which we have covered in the General Government budget for this year. Haynes indicated he has reviewed the contract and has made recommendations to Brad Thompson who drafted the contract. In paragraph 18 he suggests adding "and Goodlettsville" in the statement to "to indemnify and hold harmless Metro". Consistent with those changes, he recommends adding "and Goodlettsville" in other sections pertaining to notice provisions and making sure we are indemnified. Motion was made by Garrett to approve Resolution No. 03-268, subject to the approval of the City Attorney, seconded by Driver. Passed 3-0.

John Callis, 683 Long Hollow Pike, requested the City make repairs and maintenance to their gravel road that serves four families off Long Hollow Pike. He also requested a street name and street sign to hopefully get postal service to their homes. Mayor Jones asked Jack Tompkins to check on this matter.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
