The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jeff Cordell. Motion by Cordell, seconded by Long to approve the minutes of the August 23, 2001 regular meeting. Passed 5-0.

Consider Ordinance No. 01-609, an ordinance to abandon a dedicated right-of-way at the intersection of Connell and Cartwright Streets. David Wilson stated Bill Terry requested this item be deferred pending a submission from the surveyor which was a condition of the Planning Board's approval. Motion by Driver to defer, seconded by Cordell. Passed 5-0.

Consider Ordinance No. 01-612, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 73-161 to update the City's written OSHA program. Wilson stated this ordinance is in response to OSHA's recommendation after their recent inspection. Motion by Long to approve Ordinance No. 01-612 on second reading, seconded by Driver. Passed 5-0.

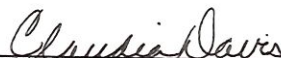
Mayor Jones wished David Wilson a Happy Birthday.

Long questioned Williams if there had been any feedback on the speed limit change along Main Street. Williams stated warning citations are being issued. Long stated he would like to see some type of additional sign installed to draw attention to the new speed limit, such as a large orange lettered sign over the regular sign. Driver reminded him the time required to secure and install the custom lighted sign was 90 days.

David Wilson stated in response to the objections from Mr. Charles Harris of Prime Mortgage to the denial of his request to remove the "No U-Turn" at Moss Trail and Rivergate Parkway, Jack Tompkins is looking into the possible consideration of a traffic signal at the southbound exit ramp off of I-65.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jim Thomas.

Consider approval of Change Order #1 to Conference Drive utility relocation contract with Sessions Paving Company, Inc. Jack Tompkins explained that the major portion of this job is complete. There have been some miscellaneous additions to the line items for a net increase of \$12,992.69. One of the changes involved correcting the original sewer service line from Music City Shopping Center which was not as deep as the trunk line so it had been run down Conference Drive until the proper depth was reached. The Arby's restaurant had a similar situation. Another part of the change order involves a major design error where the line will have to be reworked from Long Hollow to a connection point on Conference Drive as the line at the connection point
