

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: August 23, 2001

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Johnny Long. Motion by Driver, seconded by Long to approve the minutes of the August 9, 2001 regular meeting. Passed 3-0.

Presentations were made to the players and coaches of the 10 Yr. Old Girls State Champion Softball Team, 11-12 Yr. Old All-Star Boys State Champion Baseball Team, and the 13 Yr. Old All-Star State Champion Boys Baseball Team.

Consider Ordinance No. 01-609, an ordinance to abandon a dedicated right-of-way at the intersection of Connell and Cartwright Streets. Bill Terry stated the Planning Board has approved this item. He explained this area of Connell Street right-of-way was cut off by the development of I-65 and has no function as a potential roadway. The building for Old Hickory Tool & Die was built across the right-of-way. The property involved is all owned by the same person. The owners have dedicated additional road right-of-way to the City along Cartwright Street. Motion by Driver to approve Ordinance No. 01-609 on first reading, seconded by Long. Passed 3-0.

Consider Ordinance No. 01-610, an ordinance to change the speed limit on Main Street from Cima Drive to the county line from 40 mph to 30 mph. Brasier stated the signs will be made by September 7th when the ordinance goes into effect. Motion by Long to approve Ordinance No. 01-610 on second reading, seconded by Driver. Passed 3-0.

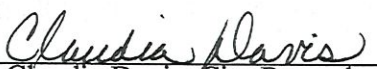
Consider Ordinance No. 01-611, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 01-604 modifying Title 17 section 106 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, by adding and deleting various provisions of the refuse and trash disposal policy. Haynes indicated he has reviewed this ordinance and approved the form and content. Motion by Long to approve Ordinance No. 01-611 on second reading, seconded by Driver. Passed 3-0.

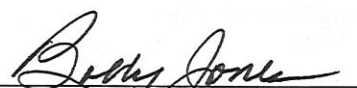
Consider Ordinance No. 01-612, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 73-161 to update the City's written OSHA program. Wilson stated the City has had a written OSHA program since 1973. The last OSHA inspection was in July and one of their recommendations was to update the written policy. This form ordinance presented for first reading will be reviewed and revised by the City Attorney prior to the second reading. Motion by Driver to approve Ordinance No. 01-612 on first reading, seconded by Long. Passed 3-0.

Charles Hagood, Chairman of the Soccer Program addressed the Commission to express his appreciation to the City for all their support of the soccer program. He reviewed the league accomplishments over the past two years and praised the development of the soccer complex at Moss Wright Park. He stated they would like to host a tournament in the future which would involve 125+ teams. He requested the Commission consider a larger concessions area, additional parking and more restrooms as future improvements. Marco, an instructor from Italy, stated that in his country everyone plays soccer, but only the professionals play on fields like the soccer fields at Moss Wright and he was also very appreciative. Mayor Jones thanked everyone for their good representation of the City and for attending the meeting and showing their appreciation.

David Wilson reminded everyone of the Gospel Music Festival at Moss Wright Park August 25th from Noon until 10:00 pm, and that Congressman Bob Clement will be meeting on Wednesday, August 29th from 2:30 to 3:30 with his constituents in Massie Chambers.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:17.
