

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: July 27, 2000

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jerry Garrett. Motion by Driver, seconded by Long to approve the minutes of the July 13, 2000 regular meeting. Passed 4-0.

Consider **Ordinance No. 00-601**, an ordinance to establish \$5,000 as the minimum amount of purchase for which sealed bids must be taken. Motion by Long to approve **Ordinance No. 00-601** on second reading, seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Consider **Resolution No. 00-222**, to amend Purchasing Procedures to establish \$5,000 as the minimum amount of purchase for which sealed bids must be taken, and to establish \$500 as the maximum amount for Departmental Purchase Orders to be written by Department Heads. Motion by Driver to approve **Resolution No. 00-222**, seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Driver stated the amount requested for new goals for the soccer fields has been revised to an estimate of \$12,841. These are regulation goals and they can be used for tournament play. John Wright indicated the funds are available in the operating budget. Motion by Driver to approve \$12,841 expenditure for the new soccer goals, seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Garrett congratulated the three incumbent Commissioners who are unopposed in the upcoming election, adding that this is a statement to the good job they have done. Driver stated that now all five commissioners have run for election unopposed.

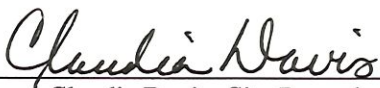
Long expressed his appreciation to the staff for the preparations toward the welcome and announcement event for IBP Corporation on Friday. Wilson echoed Long's compliments, stating that the City's employees are always willing to do whatever is needed.

Wilson stated Todd Moore has presented updated copies of our codification of ordinances. He has prepared an ordinance to adopt this codification. Motion by Long to approve **Ordinance No. 00-602** on first reading, seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Wilson stated the Fire Department requests \$2,200 to \$2,500 for a capital expenditure to replace their riding lawn mower. Driver recommended to Chief Gibson that he get a couple of goats. Garrett stated there is no grass due to the drought so there is no need for a new mower. Gibson stated the old mower can be sold at the auction. Motion by Long to approve \$2,200 to \$2,500 for a new mower, seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Wilson stated he has received a letter of resignation from Mary Ann Gourley for her position on the Planning Board. Mayor Jones asked that suggestions be submitted to him for a new member to be approved at a future Commission meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
