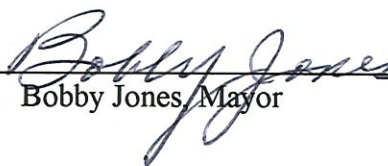
The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by David Wilson.

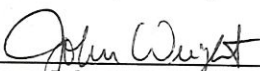

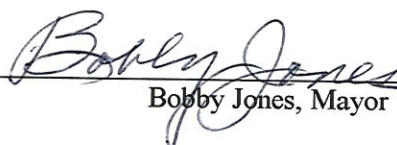
