

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: March 11, 1999

The meeting was called to order by Vice-Mayor Long. Prayer was offered by Joe Haynes. On a motion by Thomas, seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the February 25 regular meeting were approved by a vote of 3-0.

The Vice-Mayor asked that items 2, 3, and 4 on the agenda be deferred due to the absence of Mayor Jones and Commissioner Driver. Motion by Garrett to defer action on items 2, 3, and 4 to the next meeting. Seconded by Thomas. Passed 3-0.

Consider a request from Calvary Chapel to connect to the city wastewater system by installing a pressure line in the right-of-way of Willis Branch Road. The City Engineer explained that the church has an option to purchase land for a new building but that there would be problems with a normal septic system. They propose to pay all expenses related to construction and future repairs or relocation of a pressure line connecting to the city system. Motion by Garrett to approve the connection subject to the City Attorney's satisfaction with an agreement that binds the church for future expenses of the line and the City Engineer's satisfaction with the design of the project. Seconded by Thomas. Passed 3-0.

Commissioner Thomas stated that he had met with Mayor Bredesen about the 911 situation. Details of the meeting are in a written report submitted to the commissioners.

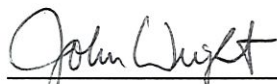
The Vice-Mayor welcomed members of Boy Scout Troop 182.

Joe Gaskins, chairman of the Youth Sports Council composed of the presidents of all the leagues using city park facilities, spoke to inform the commission of the formation of the council and to thank the City for its support of youth recreation programs.

The City Manager presented to the commissioners a packet of information related to the employee sick leave policy. He asked for future consideration of an amendment to provide for sick leave for the illness or injury of a member of an employee's household.

He also announced that a TDOT public hearing on a proposed I-65 construction project will be held at the Old Center School on March 16 from 5:00 to 7:00 pm.
