

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: June 11, 1998

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jim Driver. On a motion by Driver, seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the May 28 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Consider on first reading and public hearing Ordinance No. 98-563, an ordinance adopting a budget and establishing a property tax rate for the fiscal year July 1, 1998, through June 30, 1999. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. The City Manager pointed out that due to the reappraisal of property in Sumner County, the rate for that county will be the certified rate, which is unknown at this time. The rate can be amended on second reading, if known by then, or later by a separate ordinance. Motion by Thomas to pass Ordinance No. 98-653 on first reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 98-564, an ordinance to set the date of a city election to fill two positions on the Board of Commissioners. The City Manager stated that the traditional date for a city election is either the first Tuesday or the first Thursday in October. Motion by Garrett to pass on first reading Ordinance No. 98-564, to call for a city election on Thursday, October 1. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0. The City Attorney pointed out that the deadline for filing qualifying petitions will be in July.

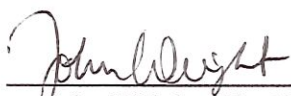
Commissioner Garrett thanked the other commissioners for the smooth and orderly budget work sessions over the past two days. The Mayor thanked the City Manager and the Finance Director for their work on the budget. Commissioner Driver seconded those remarks.

The Police Chief requested approval for a capital expenditure of \$42,400 to replace two patrol cars that were recently wrecked. The proceeds from insurance coverage will be about \$21,000. Motion by Garrett to approve a capital expenditure of \$42,400 for two patrol cars. Seconded by Thomas. Passed 4-0.

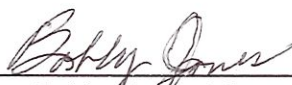
The Fire Chief requested approval for capital expenditures of \$4000 for a floor polisher/stripper and \$2500 for an icemaker. Motion by Driver to approve capital expenditures of \$4000 for a floor polisher/stripper and \$2500 for an icemaker. Seconded by Thomas. Passed 4-0.

The City Attorney introduced Clay Travis, a resident of the City and student at George Washington University, who will be interning this summer at Haynes and Freeman.
