

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Joe Haynes. On a motion by Long, seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the March 26 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Consider a request to amend Ordinance No. 64-77 regulating the number of liquor licenses in the City of Goodlettsville. There was no motion and no action taken.

Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 98-558, an ordinance to amend Title 4 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code by repealing the existing Chapter 2, "Dangerous Buildings" and replacing it with a new Chapter 2, "Slum Clearance and Redevelopment." The Planning Director explained that the current ordinance does not comply with state law regarding liens placed on property. The City Attorney stated that he has reviewed the ordinance and recommends approval. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 98-558 on first reading. Seconded by Thomas. Passed 4-0.

Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 98-559, an ordinance to abandon the right-of-way at Long Hollow Pike and State Auto Insurance property, Sumner County tax map 143-O, parcel 3. The Planning Director explained that the small parcel was created when the new Long Hollow Pike was built and currently serves no purpose. The Planning & Zoning Board recommends abandoning the right-of-way. Motion by Thomas to pass Ordinance No. 98-559 on first reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

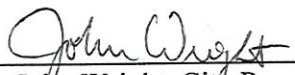
Consider Resolution No. R98-193 to accept the streets, sewers, and drainage structures in Long Hollow Place, Section 2. The Planning Director stated that the subdivision is complete and all inspections have been made. The Planning & Zoning Board recommends accepting the improvements. Motion by Garrett to adopt Resolution No. R98-193. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

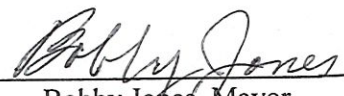
Pam Garrett handed out information to the commissioners about the upcoming Goodlettsville 40th Birthday Party and Commissioner Roast.

The City Manager stated that Metro Public Works had expressed its appreciation for the assistance given by the Goodlettsville Public Works Department in cleaning up after last week's tornado.

The City Engineer requested adoption of a resolution to enter into an agreement with Jones & Jones Construction Services Inc for drainage improvements in or around Hollywood Street. The cost of the project is \$63,158.87. Motion by Long to adopt Resolution No. R98-194. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.
