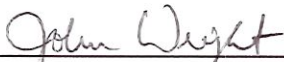
The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones.

Prayer was offered by Jim Driver.

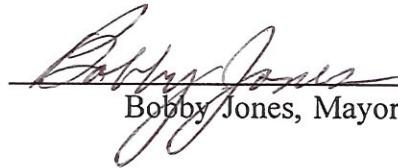
Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 98-555, an ordinance to enter into a contract with Carpenter & Company to construct the Historic Mansker Station Interpretive Center in Moss-Wright Park. The Purchasing Director stated that Carpenter & Company was the second lowest bidder, the lowest bidder having withdrawn his bid. Carpenter's original bid was \$670,000 but several items have been removed from the contract, bringing the cost down to \$621,000. The contractor is ready to begin work, and the City Attorney has reviewed and approved the contract. The contract calls for construction to be completed in fourteen months, but the contractor has stated his intention to complete the work in eight months. Commissioner Thomas pointed out that on one page of the contract the amount is shown as \$621 which should be corrected to \$621,000. Motion by Driver to pass Ordinance No. 98-555 on first reading. Seconded by Garrett. Motion by Thomas to defer action to the next regular meeting. That motion died for lack of a second. The motion to pass on first reading was approved 4-0, with Jones, Long, Garrett, and Driver voting for and Thomas abstaining.

The City Manager stated that the original low bidder will appear at the next meeting to protest the calling of his bid bond.

The meeting adjourned at 11:42 a.m.
