The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Joe Haynes.

On a motion by Garrett, seconded by Driver, the minutes of the June 12 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

The Mayor and Park Director presented plaques to the players and coaches on the Beech High School TSSAA Girls Softball Class AAA state championship team. The Mayor also read and presented a proclamation honoring the team.

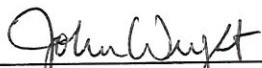
Consider on second reading and public hearing Ordinance No. 97-545, an ordinance to adopt a budget for the 1997-1998 fiscal year. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. The City Manager explained that the property tax rate is not included in the budget ordinance because the certified rate has not yet been officially determined by the Board of Equalization. The City Attorney recommended that a separate ordinance be passed to set the property tax rate. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 97-545 on second reading. Seconded by Thomas. Passed 4-0. Commissioner Garrett stated that he would like for a study of the pay schedule for grades 9 through 12 to be made early in the next quarter to clarify the raises given in the budget. Motion by Driver to pass on caption on first reading Ordinance No. 97-547, an ordinance to set a property tax rate of \$0.19 per \$100.00 assessment for the Davidson County portion of the city, being the certified tax rate for 1997, and a rate of \$0.22 per \$100.00 for the Sumner County portion of the city. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Consider on second reading and public hearing Ordinance No. 97-546, an ordinance to amend the Goodlettsville Municipal Code by amending the sewer tap fee charges. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 97-546 on second reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

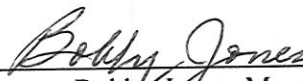
