The meeting was called to order by Vice-Mayor Long. Prayer was offered by David Wilson.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Thomas, the minutes of the March 13 meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

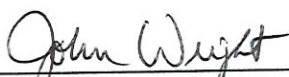
Consider on public hearing and second reading Ordinance No. 97-541, an ordinance to amend Title 11 of the Municipal Code by amending Chapter 11, Section 11-1104, Table VII, regarding permitted uses and structures in residential planned unit developments. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Vice-Mayor declared the public hearing closed. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 97-541 on second reading. Seconded by Thomas. Passed 4-0.

The Vice-Mayor announced the Mayor's appointment of Phil Cornett and David Brooks to fill the two vacancies on the Industrial Development Board. Motion by Thomas to accept the appointments. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Commissioner Garrett asked about the status of the sewer problem on Mason Lane. The City Engineer stated that during flooding conditions sewage flows out of a manhole and into Mansker Creek. The Corps of Engineers has indicated that cleaning the channel might reduce the flooding, and the new Mansker Creek trunk line should relieve the backup caused by the pump station.

Commissioner Thomas reported that the committee to study the complaint of Chuck Crook had met and that a final report would be made after the Planning & Zoning Board considers accepting the subdivision's public improvements at its next meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
