

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: March 13, 1997

Time: 6:30pm

Place: City Hall

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jerry Garrett.

On a motion by Thomas, seconded by Driver, the minutes of the February 27 meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 97-543, an ordinance to amend Title 11 of the Municipal Code by amending Chapter 11, Section 11-901, to provide standards and regulations for telecommunication facilities. The Planning Director stated that the purpose of the ordinance is to regulate the construction of towers and other facilities in accordance with state and federal laws. The Planning Board will be studying the matter, writing the body of the ordinance, and making a recommendation to the Commission. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 97-543 on first reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 5-0.

The Mayor reappointed to various City boards the following members whose terms had expired and who had attended at least 75% of the meetings as required by ordinance: Mary Ann Gourley to the Planning and Zoning Board; Ellie Mead to the Board of Zoning and Sign Appeals; James E. Smith to the Beer Board; Claude Garrison and Leroy Rice to the Industrial Development Board; Walter Todd and Johnny Childers to the Goodlettsville Hearing Authority; Harold Moon and James C. Ford to the Construction Board of Adjustment and Appeals; Pam Garrett, Roy Upton, and Glen Freudenthal to the Tourism Board. Members whose terms have expired and who did not have a 75% attendance record will be sent letters asking if they still want to serve on the boards. Motion by Garrett to approve the reappointments made by the Mayor. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

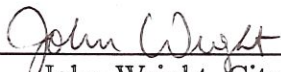
Commissioner Long pointed out that the resolution honoring Billy Hitt had not been adopted. Motion by Long to adopt Resolution No. R97-182 to honor the late Billy Hitt for his thirty-seven years of service on the Planning and Zoning Board. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Long also expressed concern about the unsafe intersection at the corner of Dickerson Road and Old Springfield Highway. He requested that the City Manager and Senator Haynes contact Tennessee Department of Transportation officials to get the process started to correct the problem.

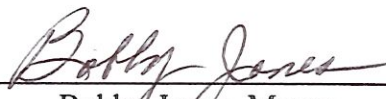
Commissioner Thomas also expressed concern about safety at the intersection of Long Hollow Pike and Madison Creek Road once the new elementary school is complete. He requested that a traffic signal of some kind be considered during the planning of the road improvements needed for the school. Commissioner Garrett suggested that a school patrol mother at that location would help the situation.

Chuck Crook, a builder in Goodlettsville, complained that, without being notified in advance, \$500 of his construction bond was used to repair a sewer line that he did not think was his responsibility. The Mayor appointed the City Manager, the City Engineer, and Commissioner Thomas as a committee to investigate the complaint and report back to the commission.

The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
